

TASTE OF TIMES SQUARE: ANNUAL OUTDOOR FOOD AND MUSIC FESTIVAL CELEBRATES THE TASTES AND SOUNDS OF NEW YORK CITY

(New York, N.Y.) – Taste of Times Square – an annual outdoor food and music festival organized by the Times Square Alliance – will offer visitors the opportunity to enjoy a world of dishes from Times Square’s top restaurants and music from the city’s best musicians on **Monday, June 5th from 5:00 – 9:00 p.m. on 46th St. between Broadway and 10th Avenue.**

Dozens of Times Square restaurants will be serving up tastes of their signature dishes for as little as \$1. Participating restaurants this year include Applebee's, B.B. Admission is free. “Taste” tickets are \$1 each and can then be redeemed for dishes, ranging from \$1-\$6, at each restaurant booth.
